

Heritage Trace Tennis/Basketball Court Rules

By accessing and using the community amenities, you agree to accept all liability associated with using the amenities, understand the risk that COVID-19 may be present in spite of the Association's best efforts to mitigate this risk, and you agree to follow all aspects of the executive order and department of public health guidelines. If you feel you are unable or unwilling to accept these risks or comply with the stated guidelines, you are not permitted to use the amenities.

If you are sick, have a fever or other symptoms of COVID-19 such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell, or currently have tested positive for COVID-19, you may not enter or use the HT Amenities.

1. Tennis, basketball, and pool amenities are for use only by those who have paid the additional amenities fee.
2. GA Executive Order 05.12.2020 must be adhered to.
3. You are responsible for properly sanitizing area and any used common areas before and at the end of your amenity use.
4. For safety reasons, no one other than the actual players should be inside the court enclosures. No more than 10 people together at one time.
5. Reserve your court for tennis only at www.ReserveMyCourt.com up to 20 days in advance. Each resident may reserve a court for a maximum of 2 hours per day, not to exceed 4 hours for any household. You will need to create an account and select Heritage Trace as your neighborhood courts. The required code for Heritage Trace is 4561.
6. If you reserve a court and later decide not to play, PLEASE make every effort to cancel your reservation and make that time available. Any reservation unfulfilled after 15 minutes is relinquished. Non-HT-Residents or Non-Amenities-Paying-Residents may not schedule courts for any matches, practices, lessons, etc.
7. The tennis pavilion is reserved for those who are playing tennis. The pool pavilion is for pool use and may be reserved at www.ReserveMyCourt.com. See pool rules for more information.
8. The courts are not to be used for any purpose other than tennis or basketball. No rollerblading, hockey playing, skateboarding, etc. is permitted within the court area.
9. Only regulation, flat, non-marking tennis shoes are permitted on the courts. Any other type of shoes, including Lugs, boots, loafers, sandals, and jogging shoes are prohibited as they may cause damage to the

- courts. Shoes shall be free of sand and mud prior to entering the court enclosures. No black-soled shoes permitted.
10. No basketball is permitted during tennis play. Tennis takes precedence over basketball.
 11. No dunking or hanging on the basketball rim.
 12. Proper sport attire is required. Wet bathing suits are not permitted. Shirts must be worn at all times.
 13. Please observe proper tennis etiquette when using the courts. All players must conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. No loud or quarrelsome conduct or profanity is permitted.
 14. Public intoxication is not permitted on the tennis courts or in the pool/tennis spectator area.
 15. No spitting is permitted on the tennis courts.
 16. Striking or throwing your racquet into the nets or fences is prohibited.
 17. Those using the pool amenities please respect play in progress.
 18. For your safety, do not play when the courts are wet. If the courts are damp, please squeegee/dry the courts before playing. Rehang squeegees/rollers after use.
 19. No pets are permitted within the court enclosures.
 20. No chairs, stools, or furniture are permitted within the court enclosures.
 21. Do not move pool furniture.
 22. No food permitted on the courts.
 23. No glass containers permitted on courts.
 24. No smoking anywhere inside the outer-most fenced areas. No smoking on courts.
 25. Please deposit trash in the proper receptacles. Please do not leave any trash (old balls, beverages, etc.) on the courts when you leave. Empty court receptacles after play.
 26. Roller Squeegees are provided for drying wet courts. Please be sure to return them to their designated hangers after use and keep them there when not being used.
 27. Tennis gates shall be kept closed during play and upon exiting the courts.
 28. Turn off court lights after play.
 29. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
 30. No markings or drawing with chalk or other on the courts
 31. All guests must be accompanied by a resident, with a 3 guests per resident per day maximum. HT residents who do not pay the amenities fee are not permitted as a guest of a HT resident who does pay the amenities fee.
 32. All Tennis teams playing out of Heritage Trace shall be Captained by a Resident/Property Owner who is in 'good standing' with the HTAOA Board. Non-Residents may NOT be a Captain but may be Co-Captain of a team.
 33. All 'Out-Of-The-Neighborhood' players that are on a HT team roster shall pay a \$35 OOTN Fee for each team for each season. If a player is on 2 separate HT teams during the same season (ex. USTA and ALTA) they

- are to pay on each team for each season through any year. This money should be turned into the HT Tennis Coordinator, BEFORE the start of any season. Captains must collect dues and submit a single check to the HT Tennis Coordinator before the first match of the season. Failure to do so, will prohibit any practice or match time being scheduled through the Court Reservation System until ALL fees have been paid. Failure to pay on time may also forfeit any right to selected practice night which may be then filled by another team.
34. In regard to teams selecting a practice night, when there are multiple teams playing simultaneously in any given season (ex: Mens and Womens ALTA), the teams will have preferential selection of practice night based on the percentage of team members that are residents of Heritage Trace. That is to say, the team with the highest percentage of HT residents will have first selection of preferred practice night. Next selections will follow in order of resident percentage of their team. Failure to pay required OOTN dues on time may also forfeit any right to selected practice night which may be then filled by another team.
 35. Courts are open from 9:00am – 10:00pm.
 36. Pool and courts areas are under 24-hour video surveillance.
 37. Be aware that anyone discovered vandalizing, damaging or destroying any property will be responsible for the repair or replacement of that property. Persons responsible will be liable.
